- This project aims to address European youth's financial illiteracy. Youth is transitioning into the phase where they make important financial decisions, facing a complex financial world filled with challenges and opportunities.
- The EU reports that 52% of adults are financially literate, with Northern Europe doing better. Approximately half of EU adults lack a full comprehension of basic financial concepts, according to the OECD/INFE 2020 international survey on adult financial literacy.
- The consortium will **focus on youth and young adults** who are still trying to find their way in the market while also learning how to manage their spending.
